Male & Female Community Coach of the Year

A qualified coach who has made a major contribution to the lives of people, through their coaching. They are a role model for those they coach, supporting them to reach the best of their abilities.

Unsung Hero of the Year (under & over 21yrs)

An individual, other than a coach, who works tirelessly behind the scenes to make sure a club / organisation / session can operate.

Primary & Secondary School Team of the Year

A school team of 2 or more who have achieved success in their chosen sport, whilst showing great sportsmanship, motivation and determination.

Club Team of the Year

A community club team of 2 or more who have achieved success, whilst showing great sportsmanship, motivation and determination.

Elite Performer of the Year (under & over 16yrs)

An individual who has excelled in their chosen sport, showing an outstanding level of performance in training and competition.

Primary & Secondary Sports School of the Year

A school that has provided excellent sporting opportunities to its students, offering innovative ideas to increase physical activity levels, engaging with local and national groups/campaigns, and having a positive impact on the wellbeing of its pupils.

Community Club of the Year

Recognition for clubs who have made a large contribution to the local sporting community.

Community Project of the Year

Recognition for a project that has shown commitment to the development of sport or physical activity and has positively engaged the community.

Service to Further Education / Higher Education

Recognition for individuals who have made a positive contribution to the development of sport at their school / college / university and have inspired more people to get involved.

Service to Sport

Recognition for individuals who have shown outstanding long term commitment to sport as a volunteer over a number of years using innovative ideas to develop / enhance their sport and widening the opportunities for participation.

Contribution to Disability Sport

A volunteer, coach, athlete, club or organisation who has significantly contributed to developing disability sport either in a school or community environment.

Disability Athlete of the Year

An individual who has excelled in their chosen sport and shown an outstanding level of performance in training and competition.

Disability Coach of the Year

A qualified coach who has made a major contribution to the lives of disabled people, whether in a school or community environment.
